- 1. Learn about the art of Towel Origami.
- 2. Know the basic equipment needed for Towel Origami.
- 3. Learn the different types of folds needed for Towel Origami.
- 4. Learn the Creation Story found in Genesis 1.
- 5. Look for and read other stories in the Bible involving animals.
- 6. Learn to make at least three (3) Towel Origami animals:
 - a. could include: swan, elephant, mouse
- 7. Learn three (3) fun facts about each of the three (3) animals you made from towels.
- 8. Create a Noah's Ark or Garden of Eden scene with the Towel Origami you created.
- 9. Create your own original Towel Origami creation and share.

Helps

- 1. The origins of Towel Origami are sketchy but probably began in ancient Egypt. Most recently folded towel animals have shown up on cruise ships.
- 2. Towels of various sizes, optional: colored paper eyes and nose, sun glasses, buttons.
- 3. Folds: vertical, horizontal, thirds, quarters. Rolls: parallel, diagonal.
