Recycling

- 1. Explain what recycling is and why it is important.
- 2. Record your family's recyclables for one week.
- 3. What item does your family recycle the most?
- 4. Save all your aluminum cans for a four-week period then cash them in at a recycling center.
- 5. Make a usable item from recyclables.
- 6. Get recycling containers for your Adventurer meeting place and recycle craft, snack, and study materials.

Helps

- 1. Definition: <u>Treating used materials from manufactured articles to make them reusable.</u> It is important to reuse materials as much as possible to prevent depleting available supplies or harming the earth to get more materials.
- 2. Suggestion: use boxes or paper grocery bags to sort glass, paper/cardboard, aluminum/metal, plastic, newspaper.
- As per family. (glass, paper/cardboard, aluminum/metal, plastic, newspaper)
- 4. Suggestions: a. ask family and friends to add to your collection; b. collect cans from a school or church function.
- 5. Suggestions: a. collage from magazine pictures, laminate into place mats; b. cover an inexpensive terra cotta pot with family pictures, decoupage and use as a pencil holder; c. cover a shoe box with old stamps, maps or other interesting papers; d. decoupage an old tray, box, or old wooden picture frame.
- 6. As per club.
