## Little Lamb Level

1. Repeat several times as a group Esther 9:30 lp: We pray that all of you will live in peace and safety. CEV
2. What should you do if you are lost?
3. How should you safely cross a street?
4. How should you safely travel in a car?
5. How should you safely ride a bike or any wheeled conveyance?
6. Play a Safety game.
7. Do a Safety craft.

### Helps

1. This verse only works in the Contemporary English Version. Other versions don't use the word safety.

Don't just talk about numbers 2-5. Roll play and practice what you are talking about, so Adventurers can use all their senses to learn.

2. When you realize you are lost stay in the same place, wait for your parent or guardian to find you. Don't go with a stranger! Stress that they must not go anywhere with anyone else! Police and/or Firefighters can help you find your parent/guardian.
3. Hold your parent or guardian's hand, wait until the light turns green or the white walk symbol is showing then cross carefully, looking both ways.
4. Always have your seat belt buckled; sit in a car seat or booster seat if that is appropriate for their size.
5. Always wear a helmet, stay on the sidewalk.
6. I had a hard time finding a game. I finally came up with a modification of Duck, Duck, Goose and call it Red Light, Red Light, Green Light. You may have better results, check online.
7. Crafts are not so hard to find. Check online for ideas.
