Helps

1. Definitions:
 - a. the subject or event portrayed in your photos
 - b. cutting out the background or unrelated part of a photo
 - c. text on a scrapbook page
 - d. pattern used to mark photos before cutting
 - e. frame around picture
 - f. coordinating color, pattern, journaling, and event
 - g. substance in newsprint that turns yellow with age
 - h. paper that is free of the acid that will deteriorate photos with age
2. Basics:
 - a. position subject in frame, note background, lighting
 - b. use photo-safe papers and store away from light, heat, and humidity
 - c. coordinate color, shape, size, journaling to best show off photos and event
