

The Season for Giving

1. Read Luke 2:1-20, Matthew 2:1-14 and John 3:16. What gift did God give to the world?
2. What is giving? What can Adventurers give?
3. How can giving spread joy?
4. Use various materials to make a nativity scene. Tell the story.
5. Find one way for Adventurers, with their family or club, to "give" during the holiday season.

Helps

1. Read from a children's version Bible or explain words Adventurers might not be familiar with. God gave His son to the world.
2. Discuss this as it relates to God giving us something good and Christmas as a time when people give gifts. Discuss how giving brings joy to others. Adventurers can give by helping or sharing their talents, they don't have to buy something to be able to give.
3. Discuss ways to bring joy to family/church/community, also discuss the joy the giver receives when giving.
4. Use various materials—playdough, Lego blocks, shoebox, paper, stones, felt, spools, wood. You can find ideas online.
5. Sing to shut-ins, feed homeless, rake leaves for an elderly neighbor, make cards to give to people at a nursing home or neighbors, stock food at a food bank, pick up trash, donate food to a pet shelter, organize or help with a food/toy drive. * You can find more ideas online but before you do any activity with Adventurers make sure you have made all "ahead of time" arrangements necessary for the safety of Adventurers and convenience of the entity you are serving.
