Pastor Benji had both our K-6 and 7-12 Chapels singing praises this morning. Both groups then enjoyed the skit "Sins, Spit, and Sight" by the Drama Llamas--Zach, Andreas, Natalie, Gwen, and Jessi. It was a delightful skit acting out the story Jesus healing the blind man by putting mud in his eyes.

Pastor Benji then concluded K-6 Chapel reminding our students that sometimes God asks us to get messy, but He always helps us to find a way to clean up! The man was a mess, but once he rinsed his eyes he could see! And, when that happened, people noticed! If we do the same, people will notice. When we change and become more like Jesuspeople will notice.

After the Drama Llamas performed for 7-12 Chapel, Mrs. Ferguson spoke about how to be brave for God. Sometimes God asks His people to do really big, exciting things like save a whole nation (Moses), but more often God asks us to be brave in small ways. He wants us to speak up when we see injustices or people being treated unfairly. He wants us to "do justly, love mercy, and walk humbly" as is recorded in Micah 6:8.
