Auto Accident Follow-Up Procedures

What to do in the case of an auto accident?

- 1. Stay calm
- 2. Unless injury has occurred, do your best to move the vehicle out of harm's way and off the road
- 3. When to call the police:
 - a. If substantial damage has been done to the vehicle (over \$2,000 suspected)
 - b. In case of injury or death
 - c. The accident involved an intoxicated driver
 - d. It was a hit and run
 - e. Damage done to someone else's private property (telephone poles, etc.)
 - f. When in doubt, doesn't hurt to call
- 4. DO NOT:
 - a. Do not move injured persons
 - b. Don't fight or blame
 - c. Don't admit fault
 - d. Don't let any unauthorized tow trucks pressure you into towing the vehicle
- 5. If another driver/car involved, get from each driver:
 - a. name
 - b. address
 - c. contact info
 - d. insurance policy information
- 6. If the police do get involved, get from police officer the police accident report number and name of officer
- 7. Ideally, especially in the case of a major accident, the name/address/contact info should be gotten from all willing witnesses/passengers
