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Taking People Into Your Own Life Rhythms

According to Wolfgang Simpson, the Western style of teaching is what we would call "confrontational". "which is often geared to allow people to gain intellectual control over things and then manipulate them according to their desire, and where the teaching style is usually an address, a professional monologue geared at students in an academic set-up, removed from real life.

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Taking People Into Your Own Life Rhythms

A new study finds that undergraduate students in classes with traditional stand-and-deliver lectures are 1.5 times more likely to fail than students in classes that use more stimulating, so-called active learning methods.

Jesus gave us a model: Mark 3:13-15

13 Jesus went up on a mountainside and called to him those he wanted, and they came to him. 14 He appointed twelve that they might be with him and that he might send them out to preach 15 and to have authority to drive out demons.

- Apprenticeship: Where I go you go, What I do you do, Etc...


