- 2. Pretend you are heading away from the earth, name each of the bodies in our solar system you would pass and learn a little about the makeup of each one.
- 3. Learn to identify three constellations in the night sky, one must be Orion.
- 4. Why is Orion believed to be special to Jesus coming?
- Read about the gems in the foundation of the New Jerusalem in Revelation 21: 19. Choose one to study about.
- 6. Read about Heaven in Revelation 21 and 22 with Adventurers and then let them describe and imagine what they think Heaven will be like and things they want to do when they get to Heaven.

Helps

- 2. Behind you is Venus, Mercury and the Sun. Going forward is Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune and the dwarf planet Pluto.
- 3. Look online for detailed information about the makeup of each planet. Basic information is: Earth, Mercury, Venus and Mars are made of rocks and metal (so is Pluto). Jupiter, Saturn, Neptune, and Uranus are gas (hydrogen and helium) and water (ice).
- 4. Mrs. White tells us Jesus will come through Orion when He comes. *Early Writings* page 42.
- 5. Some gems are easier to find samples of than others and it would be nice to study one they might actually be able to see a sample of.
- 6. Encourage the children to use their imaginations knowing God is planning a place more wonderful than we can even think about.
