Nature A-Z

- 1. Do a scavenger hunt looking for something for each letter of the alphabet.
- 2. Do two craft projects, using either natural materials or man-made materials, but design/craft something from nature.
- 3. Look up and then discuss Psalms 8:9. Memorize the verse.
- 4. Play two nature games.

Helps

- 1. Use what is available in your community to find an object in nature for each letter of the alphabet. Examples: visit a zoo or museum, go for a walk outside, look through magazines for pictures, or find stickers.
- 2. Foam shapes, modeling clay, things they find outside on a walk—there are so many mediums the kids can use to make a picture or make a shape. Just have it be something from nature, an animal or a nature scene, etc.
- 3. Singing the chorus "Oh Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth," can help children to remember the words to this text.
- 4. You can play word games, card games, outdoor games. Check online for ideas.
