

Nature A-Z

1. Do a scavenger hunt looking for something for each letter of the alphabet.
2. Do two craft projects, using either natural materials or man-made materials, but design/craft something from nature.
3. Look up and then discuss Psalms 8:9. Memorize the verse.
4. Play two nature games.

Helps

1. Use what is available in your community to find an object in nature for each letter of the alphabet. Examples: visit a zoo or museum, go for a walk outside, look through magazines for pictures, or find stickers.
2. Foam shapes, modeling clay, things they find outside on a walk—there are so many mediums the kids can use to make a picture or make a shape. Just have it be something from nature, an animal or a nature scene, etc.
3. Singing the chorus "Oh Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth," can help children to remember the words to this text.
4. You can play word games, card games, outdoor games. Check online for ideas.
