## Helps

1. Almost exclusively in the Southern Hemisphere. Only the Galapagos penguin is found north of the equator.
2. Fish, krill, and squid.
3. No. They are excellent swimmers though.
4. The emperor penguin is the largest (about 3 feet 7 inches tall and 77 pounds) the smallest is the little blue penguin also known as the fairy penguin (about 16 inches tall and 2.2 pounds).
5. You can learn about their unique body shape (very efficient for swimming with a large head, short neck, elongated body, and webbed feet), how long they live, (they live 15 to 20 years), their unique coloring (it's called countershading—dark on the back and white or light on the underside).
