

# Recycling

1. Explain what recycling is and why it is important.
2. Record your family's recyclables for one week.
3. What item does your family recycle the most?
4. Save all your aluminum cans for a four-week period then cash them in at a recycling center.
5. Make a usable item from recyclables.
6. Get recycling containers for your Adventurer meeting place and recycle craft, snack, and study materials.

## Helps

1. Definition: Treating used materials from manufactured articles to make them reusable. It is important to reuse materials as much as possible to prevent depleting available supplies or harming the earth to get more materials.
2. Suggestion: use boxes or paper grocery bags to sort glass, paper/cardboard, aluminum/metal, plastic, newspaper.
3. As per family. (glass, paper/cardboard, aluminum/metal, plastic, newspaper)
4. Suggestions: a. ask family and friends to add to your collection; b. collect cans from a school or church function.
5. Suggestions: a. collage from magazine pictures, laminate into place mats; b. cover an inexpensive terra cotta pot with family pictures, decoupage and use as a pencil holder; c. cover a shoe box with old stamps, maps or other interesting papers; d. decoupage an old tray, box, or old wooden picture frame.
