- 6. Do two activities about the days of creation.

Helps

- 1. If you have older Adventurers, you can have them learn more of the verses. At least read with them the verses that tell the whole creation story. Genesis 1:1-31 and 2:1-4
- 2. God. Because He wanted to make a beautiful place for us to live. He wanted to spend time with us here.
- 3. Day 1—light, day/night. Day 2—earth, sky. Day 3—land, trees, vegetation. Day 4—sun, moon, stars. Day 5—fish, birds. Day 6—animals, man. Day 7—Sabbath.
