Trucks, Cranes, and Bulldozers

- 1. List as many construction vehicles as you can.
- 2. Pick three different construction vehicles to learn more about. What is their main job? How do they work? Who operates them?
- 3. Learn the memory verse. Psalm 25:4 (ESV)
- 4. Play a construction vehicles game.
- 5. Do a puzzle involving construction vehicles.
- 6. Watch a video about construction vehicles.
- 7. Do a craft about a construction vehicle—a diorama with construction vehicles, posters/pictures, crafting a vehicle model, etc.
- 8. Make a collection of construction vehicles Adventurers have at home and let them share/talk about them.

Helps

- 1. Bulldozer, cement truck, backhoe, dump truck, loader, crane, fork lift, jackhammer, delivery truck, excavator, fuel truck, flatbed truck, etc.
- 2. The library or online will give you information.

- 4. Bingo, matching game, concentration, etc. (lots of ideas online).
- 5. Either a store-bought puzzle or make your own with a picture of a construction vehicle that you paste onto cardboard then cut up.
- 6. Online is a great source.
- 7. Use egg cartons, scrap wood, etc. Many ideas online.
- 8. Adventurer parents may operate some of these vehicles for their work or an Adventurer may have a Matchbox (or other) collection. This could be a Show and Tell type time for your kids/families.
