
Under the Sea

Helps

- 1. Help Adventurers to learn that God made us and everything in the earth including all that is in the ocean.
- 2. What you decide to study is up to you. You can start with the layers of the ocean and what thrives in each layer depending on the temperature and light, or types of sea weed. Have fun! There is plenty of information at a library or online.
- 3. This requirement is like number 2. You choose what you think your kids would like to study, (or have them help you decide), creatures from the top layer or way down deep or anything in between.
- 4. Online you will find many fun ideas.
- 5. A good game that can be changed to any theme is Observation. Have a tray of objects that match the theme you are studying, give the kids a while to study the tray and remember what is on it then take the tray away and have them try to recall as much as they can. You can vary it depending on the age of your players. Check online for more ideas.
