

Term Status -- Definition

The E16 section of the Pacific Union Education Code includes the definition of and policies regarding individuals on term status. Term status is defined as that status for full-time administrators who are employed for a specified term not to exceed three years. This definition must be additionally clarified to provide consistency throughout Northern California Conference schools.

In addition to the categories listed in the Pacific Union Education Code, term status will be applied to individuals in the following administrative positions:

- ✓ The principal of a school with four or more teachers (including the principal)
- ✓ Business managers, registrars, directors of development, directors of recruitment/marketing who teach less than 50% of their total employment assignment
