Napa Christian was awarded **\$71,184** - half a match by the Tonge foundation and the other half by our generous donors, for gymnasium improvements. We are looking forward to a new scoreboard, gym doors, and floor coverings.

Napa Christian seniors were awarded a total of \$321,850 and 7 full athletic **scholarships** to colleges including UC Davis, Pacific Union College, Walla Walla University, La Sierra University, UC Berkeley, Cal Poly, University of Cincinnati, and University of the Pacific.

We welcome **Mr. Lyle Bennett** who will be joining our staff to teach some 9 - 12 Science and Religion classes.
