THESE SCORES ARE REPORTED FOR THE STUDENT, BUT WILL NOT BE AVERAGED INTO THE CLASS REPORT.

If a student has been identified as qualifying for special education, that student does not have to take the IOWA ASSESSMENT if the teacher feels that the student cannot adequately handle the situation.

If a student is to be exempted from the regular testing program, PERMISSION MUST BE OBTAINED from the Northern California Conference Office of Education.

<u>Note</u>: A student who does not speak English the first year he/she is enrolled in school should not take the test. During the second year the student is enrolled in school, he/she should be tested, but the scores should be suppressed (not included in the scores for the class). Therefore, use code Z in the *Office Use Only* Box.
