Purpose

To assist students graduating from 12th grade who want to be a teacher in a Seventh-day Adventist school and to continue an education at a Seventh-day Adventist institution of higher education.

II
Qualifications

- A. Attendance at a Seventh-day Adventist institution of higher education.
- B. Completed application form with required attachments.
- C. Recommended by local conference office of education.

III
Scholarship Information

- A. Four year scholarship.
 - \$1,000 – years one and two [\$1,500 if attending LSU or PUC]
 - \$2,000 – years three and four [\$3,000 if attending LSU or PUC]
 - Allowance for a one-year educationally related deferral, i.e. student missions, task force, Adventist Colleges Abroad
- B. Renewal criteria:
 - 3.0 GPA from institution of higher education
 - Verification of acceptance into the teacher education program after the sophomore year.
 - Verification of acceptable progress toward the completion of a Seventh-day Adventist teaching certificate.

IV
Approval Process

- A. Complete application form with attachments is submitted to the academy principal. **Deadline: April 1.**
- B. The application form with attachments will be forwarded to the local conference superintendent of schools.
- C. One application from each conference will be recommended to the Pacific Union Office of Education. Five scholarships will be awarded each spring: One from each of the California Conferences and one representing Arizona, Hawaii and Nevada-Utah Conference.
- D. Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the Seventh-day Adventist institution of higher education once verification of enrollment is received from the institution.

Timeline for the Teacher Education Scholarship Application Process

- Post the application to our website January 1 of each year
- Completed applications with attachments must be **submitted to the academy principal** by **April 1** of each year.
- Completed applications with attachments should be forwarded from the principals to **arrive** at the NCC Office of Education **by April 15** of each year.
- Completed applications with attachments will be reviewed by the NCC Education superintendents and a vote taken, as to which one to send on to the Pacific Union Office of Education, with a recommendation that the student be the NCC recipient of the scholarship.
- Completed application with attachments of the student selected by NCC will be sent **to arrive** at the Pacific Union Office of Education **by April 30** of each year.
