

Independent Study Program (ISP) Students

Part-Time Students

1. The local school board, in consultation with the Northern California Conference Office of Education, would have the option to choose or not choose to participate. Participation by a school would involve the formation of an Acceptance Committee with the board chairperson (or designee), principal, and involved teacher(s) as members of the committee.
2. Any tuition and fees shall be determined by the local school board.
3. The student(s) would be covered by the regular student accident insurance.
4. A contract signed by the parents containing the following elements shall be required:
 - a. Days and hours of attendance.
 - b. Classes to be completed at the local school.
5. Entrance testing would be at the option of the local school.
6. The program must have annual written approval from the Northern California Conference Office of Education.
7. Approved ISP students would be included on the school's Opening Report, counted as $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, or $\frac{3}{4}$.
