




The NT clarifies the Holy Spirit's role


- In the NT, the Holy Spirit gives "spiritual gifts" to Christians to empower them to serve.

- Yoked with the Holy Spirit we have no cause for fear when serving.
- Our role is so minor compared to His!












So what are spiritual gifts? • First, what they are not — they are not • Talents (everyone has talents, only Christians have spiritual gifts. God blesses talents too) • "Fruit of the Spirit" (Gal. 5:22-23) Fruit is what we are, gifts are what we do!

So what are spiritual gifts? • They are not – • Counterfeit gifts (see Matt. 7:21-23) • Done without (through) love (1 Cor. 13:1-3)

• "God has given each of you a gift from His great variety of spiritual gifts. Use them well to serve one another." 1 Pet. 4:10


