Eligibility Requirements

Pathfinder LIT Program

- 1. Be a converted, dedicated Christian and a baptized member of the Seventh-day Adventist Church.
- 2. Be a respected community member.
- 3. *Must apply on a yearly basis* and *must* attend the Northern California conference LIT training program each year in order to advance.
- 4. Must have the recommendation of the Pathfinder director and the church pastor.
- 5. Must have been a member of any Pathfinder Club in good standing for at least one (1) year, and maintained a 75% attendance record over the same period. If transferring from another Pathfinder Club must participate in the current club activities for six (6) months or have a recommendation from the former club director.
- 6. Be in the 9th grade or above.
- 7. Be 15 years of age by December 31st of the current Pathfinder year. Age 18 is an optional year to continue as an LIT or become a senior staff member.
- 8. Must complete the basic AY Pathfinder class work and Operational Department requirements for the current year in order to advance to the next LIT level.
- 9. Must have a complete Class "A" LIT uniform. (see page 4)
- 10. Every first year LIT must serve a ninety (90) day probationary period during which the LIT sleeve strip and appropriate insignia may be worn.
