Orientation Weekend Requirements

- 1. <u>All LIT's</u> must attend the opening LIT session on Sabbath morning, Affirmation, the general session on Saturday evening, and the Sunday closing session.
- 2. All 1st and 2nd year LIT's must attend all LIT sessions and activities to receive your pin, pips and braid at the awards program on Sunday. All 3rd year and 4th year LIT's may choose to attend any breakout session and have an attendance paper signed by the *Area Coordinator* in charge of the breakout session (No other signatures will be accepted), or stay with the LIT session. In order to receive your pips all 3rd and 4th year LIT's *must* return the signed attendance paper to Don or Margaret after the last breakout session on Sabbath.
- 3. You must have permission from Don or Margaret to miss any of the sessions and/or activities.
- 4. You must participate willingly and cheerfully when asked to do something during this orientation weekend.

5. No question that you need to ask or any response you give will be considered "dumb".

- 6. Any personal information that you share during this weekend is confidential.
- 7. We will remain together as an LIT group for all general sessions and social times. The 9:00 p.m. LIT train ride is optional. Please do not plan to ride the train at any other time.
- 8. You must report immediately to your responsible Pathfinder club leader following the Saturday night activities that concludes with the train ride.
- 9. Being an LIT is a privilege to be earned. This orientation weekend is your opportunity to prove to the Northern California Conference that you qualify to be an LIT.
- 10. If an LIT candidate fails to quality for the current Pathfinder year their Club representative will be notified. A meeting with the LIT candidate, their club representative and the LIT Coordinator can be requested.
- 11. The LIT program no longer meets the 10 hour Master Guide course.
