Responsibilities of a Pathfinder LIT

- 1. Guide: You need to know where your Pathfinders are, where they are headed, what needs to be done, and how to help them get there.
- 2. Organize: You must be able to plan the work and do so by getting your Pathfinders to work together.
- 3. Communicate: 90% of our problems are due to poor communication. You need to inform everyone about the plans, needs, problems, progress and decisions.
- 4. Share the Job: Delegate jobs to your Pathfinders even if it is not as good as you can do so that they can learn.
- 5. Become a Problem Solver: Problems that are ignored will eventually resurface. Face problems with determination.
- 6. Be a Peace Maker: We need to cultivate the art of getting along with each other.
- 7. Have "Stick-to-itiveness": Giving up on a Pathfinder should not be an option. Think of another way.
- 8. Have a Vision: You must dare to believe that with God's help you can do the impossible, yet make sure your vision does not become empty talk and unkept promises.
- 9. Try to: be humble, be patient, have a sense of humor, have mature judgment, be sincere, have respect, be friendly, be a servant and be available.
- 10. Set Goals: Challenge your Pathfinders.
- 11.Have Spiritual Responsibility: Keep relationships in the right priority. Love God first, love others second and yourself last. Think About: What of these relationships exist, are they healthy and balanced, are they strong and stable and where are they headed. Walk with and know Jesus as your personal friend.
